**Pastor Peter Chernyavsky** is the second pastor of Central Baptist Church in Zhitomer, Ukraine. At Central Baptist he heads the Bible Institute, a training program for raising up ministries equipped for starting churches in remote villages in the region. Presently, Pastor Peter oversees 12 ministers as well as serving as pastor to his own church in the village of Lychin.

**The Most Rev. Livingstone Nkoyoyo** was Archbishop of Uganda from 1994 to 2004, during a time of unprecedented growth in the Province. The Province of Uganda comprises 6.7 million Anglicans, 27 dioceses and 1800 pastors.

**The Rt. Rev. C. FitzSimons (“Fitz”) Allison** was the 12<sup>th</sup> Bishop of South Carolina, and even more is a great friend of St. John’s Parish. He is also Honorary American Canon of St. Andrew’s Cathedral, Aberdeen, Scotland. A one-time professor at Virginia Theological Seminary, he is also the author of several books, including *Fear, Love, and Worship* (1962), *The Rise of Moralism* (1966), and *The Cruelty of Heresy* (1994).
